CONDITIONS OF PLAY

1. Open to MALE Bowlers only.
2. No Roll ups.
3. No dead ends: re-spot jack on the 'T'
4. 6 games of 12 ends. 3 games each day.
5. There will be a 2 hour time limit on each round. Any ends not yet played or commenced inside the time limit will remain unplayed. Games in Rounds 2, 3, 5 and 6 can start earlier but cannot finish later than the schedule permits
6. Scoring system for major prizes:
 - a) Winners will be decided by points scored & shot margin.
Win = 2 points, Draw = 1 points, loss = 0 points.
 - b) Count backs. In the event of teams being tied on points and margins the percentage formula will be used. Total shots scored divided by total shots against. (F/A=%)
 - c) No team can win more than one prize.
 - d) In the event of Teams being tied for Best Performed Ends will be counted.
7. **Positions of Play**
Team positions nominated at the start of play must remain unchanged for the duration of the tournament.
8. **Substitutes**
If a substitute is used the substitute cannot be skipper for that team.
9. **Forfeits**
 - a) In the event of a forfeit, the team/s who receives the forfeit will be awarded a win plus a margin. The forfeiting team will receive a loss minus a margin.
 - b) The margin will be the result of the aggregate of the winning teams margins divided by the number of winning teams in this round.
 - c) The margin will be rounded up or down to the nearest shot.
10. The tournament committee reserves the right to alter the procedure of play to bring the event to a successful conclusion.
11. Play in accordance with World Bowls Laws of the Sport of Bowls Crystal Mark Edition
12. In respect to our Sponsors players must attend the presentation to receive any prize money.
